Rubbish!!: At Newlands Adventure Centre we recycle most of the waste we

produce. You can help by using the recycle bins, placed around the centre and picking up any litter you see and disposing of it in the

correct bin.

Switch Off: All the lighting in the centre is low energy but you can help save even

more energy by making sure all lights are switched off when leaving a room. Heating can be also be switched off in the rooms when there is no one in them and please never leave electrical equipment on

standby.

Water, Water: Please be sensible with water and while we have push taps fitted,

please be quick in the shower and if a tap is stuck on, gently pull the

top upwards then report it to the office.

Out and About: The Lake District is a stunning area and we want to keep it like that.

Please do not drop any litter and pick up any you find. Please respect the wildlife, plants and waterways around us and there are plenty of leaflets and information on our Nature Board about the fauna and flora

of the area.
